







Distinction curtain tracks are a blend of elegance and functionality allowing effortless operation in the trickiest of situations.

Bay windows, and very wide windows & doors were a 'window dressing' nightmare until the concept of tracked poles arrived. The technology is simple – the brackets are fitted above the track meaning there is none of the traditional conflict with curtain rings hitting into them.

The Distinction range allows even a single curtain to traverse a large bay window, or cover over a patio door without being restricted.

DISTINCTION 34FLAT

DISTINCTION 20ROUND

Key Features:


- Disinction 28 Round can be corded from both sides using the intermediate pulley which will also increase the weight carrying capacity of the pole.
- Double overlap arms mean curtains remain well-dressed when open
- Roller wheels on overlaps to prevent jamming on bends
- Cut out in track to allow removal or addition of gliders
- Eyelet on the end hides unsightly cords behind curtain
- Colour matched brackets & cording sets
